'Into the Mess & Other Jesus Stories'

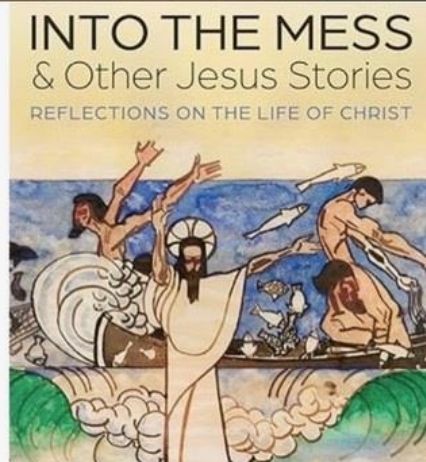

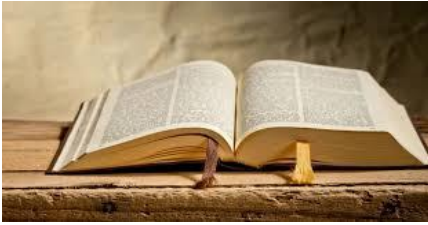

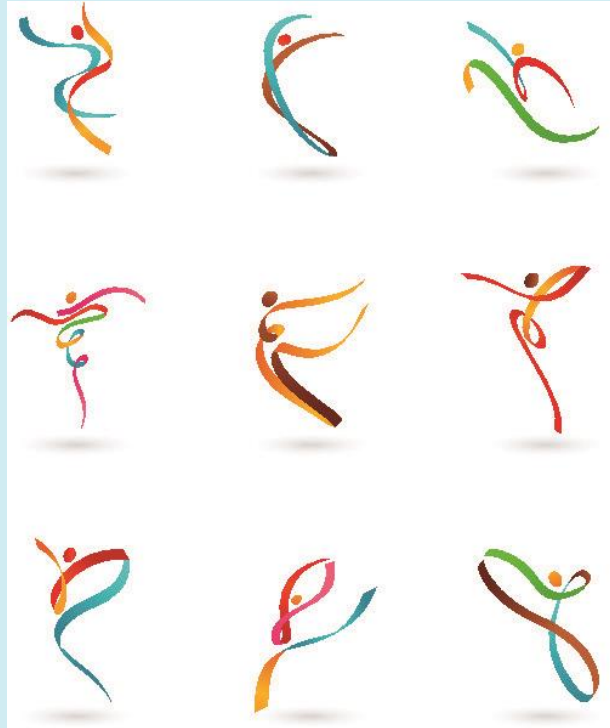
